



## MINIMUM CSU ADMISSION **REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST**

Applicants who complete all four checklist items meet the minimum CSU admission requirements. Visit calstatela.edu/admissions/freshman-admission for more information.

Complete the "A-G" courses with a grade of "C-" or better.

#### HISTORY AND SOCIAL SCIENCE

Including 1 year of U.S. history or 1 semester of U.S. history and 1 semester of civics or American government AND 1 year of social science.

- 4 years of college preparatory English composition and literature.
- 4 years recommended of college preparatory math including or integrating topics covered in algebra, geometry, and intermediate algebra.
- LABORATORY SCIENCE 2 years of college preparatory science required with laboratory (1 biological and 1 physical). Integrated science and interdisciplinary courses can meet this requirement.
- LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH 2 years or through the second level of high school instruction in the same language; American Sign Language and classical languages such as Latin and Greek are acceptable.
- VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS 1 year or 2 semester courses from the same discipline required including dance, music, theatre, visual arts, or interdisciplinary arts.
- **COLLEGE PREPARATORY ELECTIVE** Additional year chosen from the University of California "A-G" list.
- Achieve post-9th grade "A-G" GPA as follows:
  - California residents and graduates of California high schools: 2.50 GPA.
  - Non-California residents: 3.00 GPA.
- Graduate from high school or earn a GED.
- If needed, earn a passing score in one of the following exams (e.g., TOEFL, IELTS, PTE, and Duolingo English).


