**1** Complete the "A-G" courses with a grade of "C-" or better.

<b>A HISTORY AND SOCIAL SCIENCE</b> Including 1 year of U.S. history or 1 semester of U.S. history and 1 semester of civics or American government AND 1 year of social science.	✓	✓		
<b>B ENGLISH</b> 4 years of college preparatory English composition and literature.	✓	✓	✓	✓
<b>C MATH</b> 4 years recommended of college preparatory math including or integrating topics covered in algebra, geometry, and intermediate algebra.	✓	✓	✓	✓
<b>D LABORATORY SCIENCE</b> 2 years of college preparatory science required with laboratory (1 biological and 1 physical). Integrated science and interdisciplinary courses can meet this requirement.	✓	✓		
<b>E LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH</b> 2 years or through the second level of high school instruction in the same language; American Sign Language and classical languages such as Latin and Greek are acceptable.	✓	✓		
<b>F VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS</b> 1 year or 2 semester courses from the same discipline required including dance, music, theatre, visual arts, or interdisciplinary arts.	✓			
<b>G COLLEGE PREPARATORY ELECTIVE</b> Additional year chosen from the University of California "A-G" list.	✓			

**2** Achieve post-9th grade "A-G" GPA as follows:

- California residents and graduates of California high schools: 2.50 GPA.
- Non-California residents: 3.00 GPA.

**3** Graduate from high school or earn a GED.

**4** If needed, earn a passing score in one of the following exams (e.g., TOEFL, IELTS, PTE, and Duolingo English).
