### MINIMUM CSU ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

Applicants who complete all four checklist items meet the minimum CSU admission requirements. Admission to Cal State LA is competitive. Visit calstatela.edu/admissions for more information.

Complete the "A-G" courses with a grade of "C-" or better. YEAR 1 YEAR 2 YEAR 3 YEAR 4 **HISTORY AND SOCIAL SCIENCE** Including 1 year of U.S. history or 1 semester of U.S. history and V 1 semester of civics or American government AND 1 year of social science. **ENGLISH** B 4 years of college preparatory English composition and literature. MATH C 4 years recommended of college preparatory math including or integrating topics covered in algebra, geometry, and intermediate alaebra. LABORATORY SCIENCE D 2 years of college preparatory science required with laboratory (1 biological and 1 physical). Integrated science and interdisciplinary courses can meet this requirement. LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH E 2 years or through the second level of high school instruction in the  $\mathbf{V}$ same language; American Sign Language and classical languages such as Latin and Greek are acceptable. VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS F 1 year or 2 semester courses from the same discipline required including dance, music, theatre, visual arts, or interdisciplinary arts. **COLLEGE PREPARATORY ELECTIVE** G  $(\checkmark)$ Additional year chosen from the University of California "A-G" list.

Achieve post-9th grade "A-G" GPA as follows:

- California residents and graduates of California high schools: 2.50 GPA.
- Non-California residents: 3.00 GPA.

Graduate from high school or earn a GED.

If needed, satisfy the English Language Proficiency requirements (e.g., TOEFL, IELTS, PTE, and Duolingo English).
