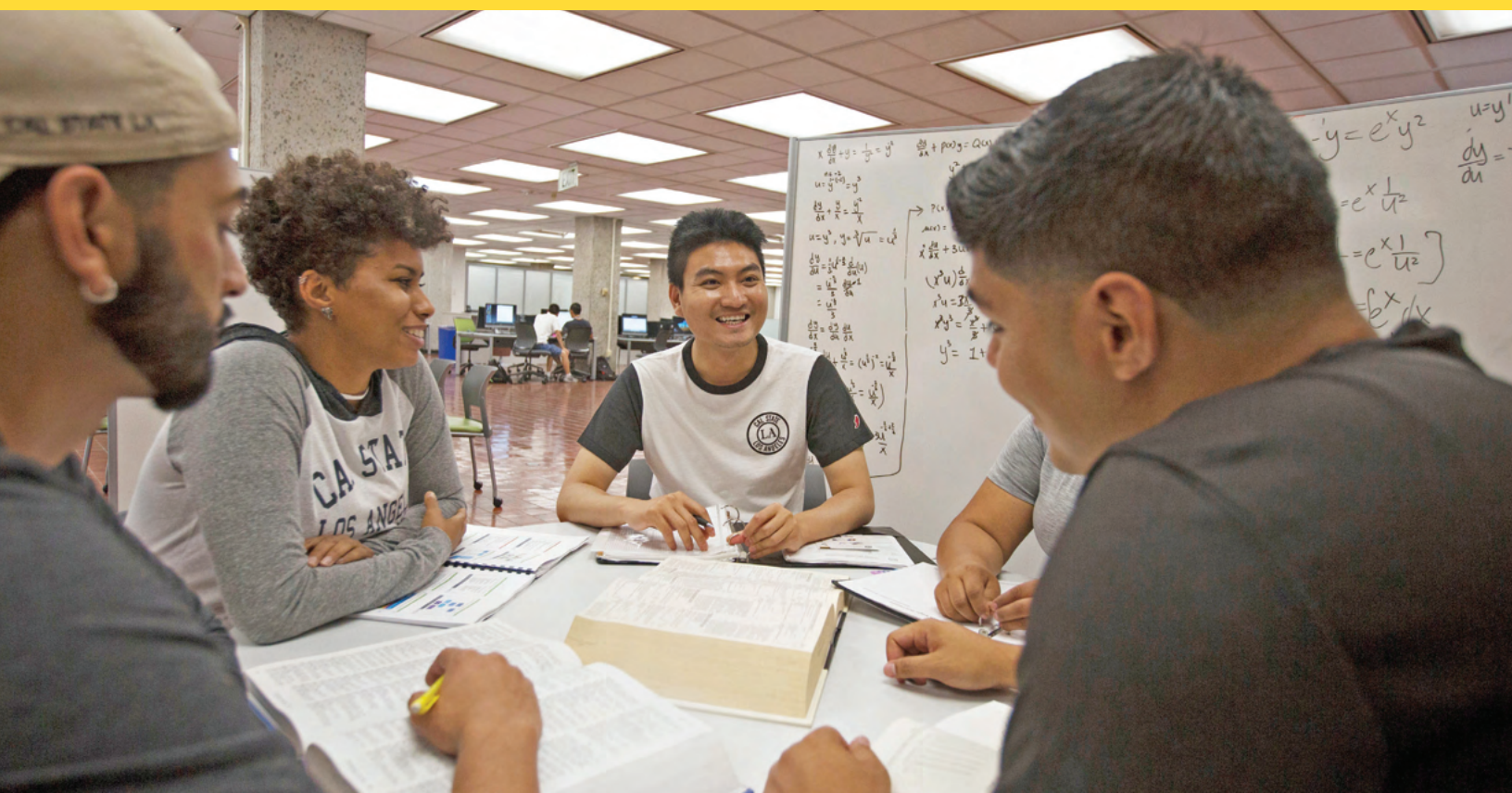

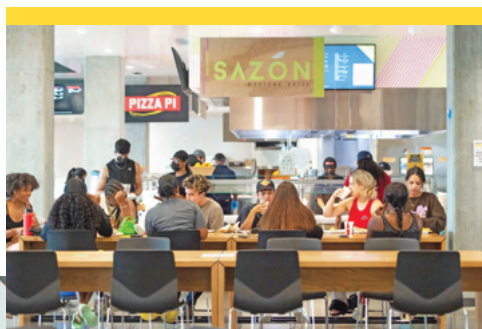

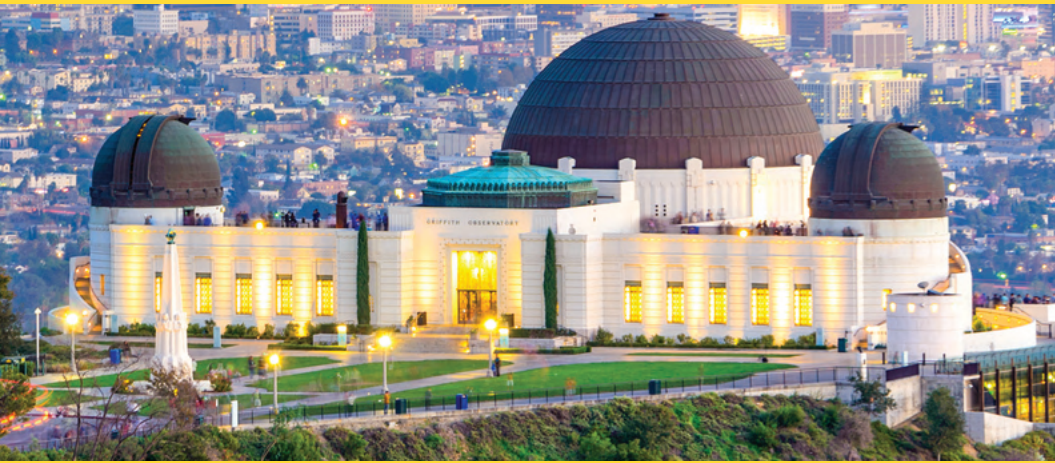

INTERNATIONAL OFFICE

Cal State LA's International Office serves the university and international community by providing a welcoming, supportive environment for international students and scholars, along with facilitating meaningful education abroad experiences, and engaging universities and partners from around the world to prepare students and professionals to be active participants in a globalized society and economy.



OUR INTERNATIONAL OFFICE OFFERS THE FOLLOWING SERVICES AND PROGRAMS:

Degree-Seeking Students

Our office provides admission and immigration information to prospective international students seeking to earn an undergraduate or graduate degree at Cal State LA. For current Cal State LA international students, our staff provides guidance on maintaining F-1 or J-1 immigration status; navigating university policies and understanding F-1 and J-1 visa restrictions. Our staff also advises students on programs such as Curricular Practical Training (CPT) and Optional Practical Training (OPT), and on learning about educational tools, including workshops and tutorials.

Bi-lateral Student Exchange Program

International undergraduate students currently attending one of Cal State LA's designated Exchange Partner universities may be eligible to participate in our international bi-lateral student exchange program. Interested students must first be nominated by their home university. Those nominated students who apply and are accepted into our exchange program will not have to pay tuition to Cal State LA during their one or two semester attendance. However, exchange students will be required to pay non-tuition related fees and housing costs. Prospective exchange students are required to be a citizen and resident of a foreign country or countries. Cal State LA does not accept dual citizens of the United States and other countries. Before applying, please speak with the international relations office to see if your home university is a Cal State LA Exchange Partner. calstatela.edu/international/exchange-programs

Semester in LA (SILA)

The Semester in LA program is a great, fee-based option for international students looking for a unique and well-rounded study abroad experience in Los Angeles. Study with award-winning faculty at Cal State LA for one or two semesters, earn university credits, and apply the credits toward graduation back home. At the same time, immerse yourself in everything Los Angeles. While you are here, walk the sunny beaches, hike the winding mountain trails, shop the one-and-only Rodeo Drive in Beverly Hills, and tour historic Hollywood, where movies are born. calstatela.edu/international/semester-la

J-1 Scholars Program

Cal State LA's J-1 Scholars Program is part of the U.S. government's J-1 Exchange Visitor Program, which was established to support visitors from other countries to participate in educational and cultural programs. The objective of the program is to increase mutual understanding between the citizens of the United States and the exchange visitors' countries. The visitors may include university graduates or post-doctoral students, faculty members, or professionals who wish to participate in studies, research, teaching, or training at Cal State LA. Interested international scholars must be nominated and sponsored by a current Cal State LA faculty member. calstatela.edu/international/J-1-scholar-program

Short-Term Programs

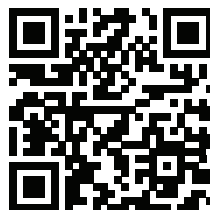

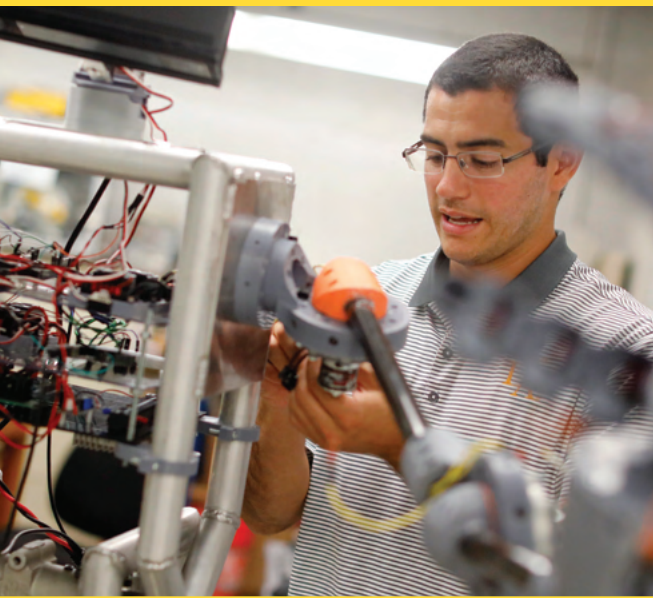
